The Belfast/Good Friday Agreement requires unionists and nationalists to work together as part of a powersharing coalition in Stormont. This means that they make decisions jointly and agree on new laws that benefit all sections of the community. For example, in 2016 they agreed not to introduce water charges in Northern Ireland.
